# Parkland Music Boosters Executive Board Meeting 

Minutes - July 7, 2022 at 7:00PM

Meeting Called to Order: Wendy Wright
Approval of Last Meeting's Minutes (May 16): After corrections made to update attendees, motion to approve by Heather. Seconded by Kevin. Approved.

## Treasurer's Report:

- Financial statement changes from last meeting included income from Amazon Smile, clothing drive, band memory book, and spiritwear sales. Expenses included concessions for FOTA, two new coolers for concessions, indoor percussion and colorguard, scholarships.
- Final profit for the year was $\$ 4108.18$ as of June 17, 2022.
- Correction to financial report: Checkbook balance should read $\$ 15382.47$ instead of $\$ 16632.47$. Savings balance is $\$ 1387.25$.
- Three checks (for Orchestra and Percussion) are outstanding. One check may need to be reissued as the original was sent to an old address. Income from FOTA concessions has not been received as the school board has not approved the checks.
- Vicki suggested that as a nonprofit organization, the treasurer's report should use the terms revenue, expenses, and surplus instead of income/profit, expenses, and reserve. Heather stated that the tax return does use the term, "profit". Issue is tabled until the next meeting.
- Motion to approve Treasurer's Report by Karen. Seconded by Voula. Approved.


## Directors' Reports (from Connie)

- Mr. Lerew reported that many students showed up for the first two dates of the freshman marching training. For the half-time show this year, the songs will be "Uptown Funk" and a medley of Daft Punk songs.
- Mrs. Lagan held chorale auditions and accepted 40 students. She is currently moving to the Lehigh Valley.
- Mr. Mishler completed video auditions for the symphonic orchestra.
- Mrs. Figueroa will continue to support Tri-M Honor Society and continue as assistant director for band and chorus. Mr. Figueroa will be taking Dr. Watson's position, teaching at the high school and elementary level.


## New Business

- 2022-2023 Standing Committees: review of current committees
o Concession Stand: Kevin Boger, chair. Organize and manage stadium concessions stand for Music Boosters
o Middle School Band Night: Organize dinner for SMS/OMS $8^{\text {th }}$ graders and PHS band when middle schoolers play with PHS band.
- Marching Band Senior Night: Connie Baxter has been organizing this. Senior recognition night at the football game requires flowers and pictures with parents.
o PMEA Chorus Auditions Committee: District auditions are in October. Organize chorus parents to run concessions stand.
- PMEA Hospitality Committee: Organizes lunch for directors at PMEA auditions for Chorus/Band/Orchestra.
- PMEA Band/Orchestra Auditions Committee: Organize concessions stand during December auditions.
- Feed the Band: Organize food/volunteers to sell concessions to band students during third quarter of the football game. Nina Weiss was training someone to take this over.
o Parent Preview Night: Band halftime show preview at the stadium.
Concessions stand sells drinks and popcorn, and band may need to be fed.
o Spirit wear Band and Orchestra: Selling Band/Orchestra logo'd clothing and items. Note that with new director, Chorus may want to join. Sydney Sherrier (colorguard and indoor percussion director) has offered to chair this. Wendy and Karen will talk to her about this.
o Clothing Drive: Spring fundraiser collecting clothing/shoes. Organize volunteers and advertising.
- Indoor Percussion Representative:

- Indoor Percussion/Colorguard Show Committee: Show scheduled for April 1 at Parkland. This is TIAA, not chapters, and could involve up to 50 groups.
o Hydration Committee/Marching Band: Sets up two water coolers during band camp and organizes water bottles for football games. Suggestion to add responsibility to this committee for putting on stadium seat covers for the band at the games.
o Music Department Semi-Formal: January semi-formal event for all music students. Event has been held at Muhlenberg for the last two years. Table centerpieces are in the shed.
o Equipment Crew for Marching Band: Michele and Jim Hare have been doing this. Maintain and move equipment (podiums, ladders, percussion) needed for band pre-game and halftime show.
o Scholarship Committee: Boosters award three scholarships (band, chorus, orchestra) to graduating seniors. Define essay topic and recruit English teachers to judge essays.
o Festival of the Arts (FOTA) Committee: Organize food and volunteers for concessions stand.
o Any suggestions of volunteers to chair any of the committees can be submitted to Wendy or Karen.


## Amendments to Standing Committees

o Indoor Percussion Representative and Colorguard Representative can be removed.

- Committee organizes volunteers for ushering and possibly selling drinks.
- Katy Mangold said that she would help this year. Kevin is looking into selling drinks (outside both gates).
- Mary will look at the bylaws to see if Katy can chair this position as an associate member.
- Motion to add DCI Committee to Standing Committees by Karen. Seconded by Vicki. Approved.
o Add Fanfare \& Tribute as a standing committee.
- Committee collects photos and organizes a memory book of the band for the year.
- Suggestion to include a Photography sub-committee to collect the photos and organize "official" photographers for each event.
- Karen volunteers as chair.
- Motion to add Fanfare \& Tribute Committee to Standing Committees by Karen. Seconded by Vicki. Approved.
- Concession Stand Cleaning Day
o Scheduled by Kevin for Saturday, August 20 from 8:00AM-12:00PM.
o Six volunteers are needed.
- Membership Sign-up
o Voula is planning to attend uniform fittings to recruit members. Karen can also help.
o Sign-up will be allowed online as well as using a paper form.
- Wendy/Connie will send the membership form to Voula.
- Wendy/Voula (and Tina) will see if Square can collect membership information in addition to processing the payments.
- Suggestion to use QR code to access online membership sign-up.
- Motion by Vicki to keep membership at $\$ 15$ but to include a magnet while supplies last and if sign-up is done in person. Seconded by Mary. Approved.
