

# Parkland Music Boosters General Membership Meeting

#### Introduction of Board Members

#### Membership:

- During uniform fittings, 52 families joined for 58 of 185 students accounting for 31% of the band.
- Message to parents that membership supports students and gives voting rights.
- Associate memberships (for other family members, friends) are available.

Approval of Last Meeting's Minutes: Postponed to next board meeting.

#### **Treasurer's Report:**

- DCI Income was \$3558.83; expense was \$1791.54. (Net proceeds: \$1767.29.)
- FOTA check was \$1466.00.
- Donations totaled \$472.50: \$216.50 from DCI and the rest from membership.
- Membership income was \$805.29.
- Spiritwear sales were \$75 (from membership signup).
- Trailer tag registration was \$6.
- Total income was \$6377.62. Expenses were \$1797.54. Profit was \$4580.08.
- Checkbook balance as of 8/15: \$21,910.09 (checking), \$1387.26 (saving)

#### **DCI Update:**

- Boosters were permitted to sell drinks and candy at the gates of J. Birney Crum stadium during the Drum Corps International Eastern Semi-Finals, a two-day event where 13,000 tickets were sold.
- One stand was set up on Friday, and two stands (one at each entrance) were set up for Saturday. Saturday sales were much better because of the two stands.
- Boosters have been invited back to sell drinks at DCI for subsequent years.
- Boosters have also been invited to sell drinks at the Collegiate Band Festival in September.

#### **Fanfare and Tribute Update:**

- The proofs are in final revision.
- Hopefully, the books will be printed and distributed in the upcoming weeks.

#### Spirit wear:

- Sydney Sherrier (colorguard) is organizing spirit wear sales.
- The online store is expected to be up and running this week.
